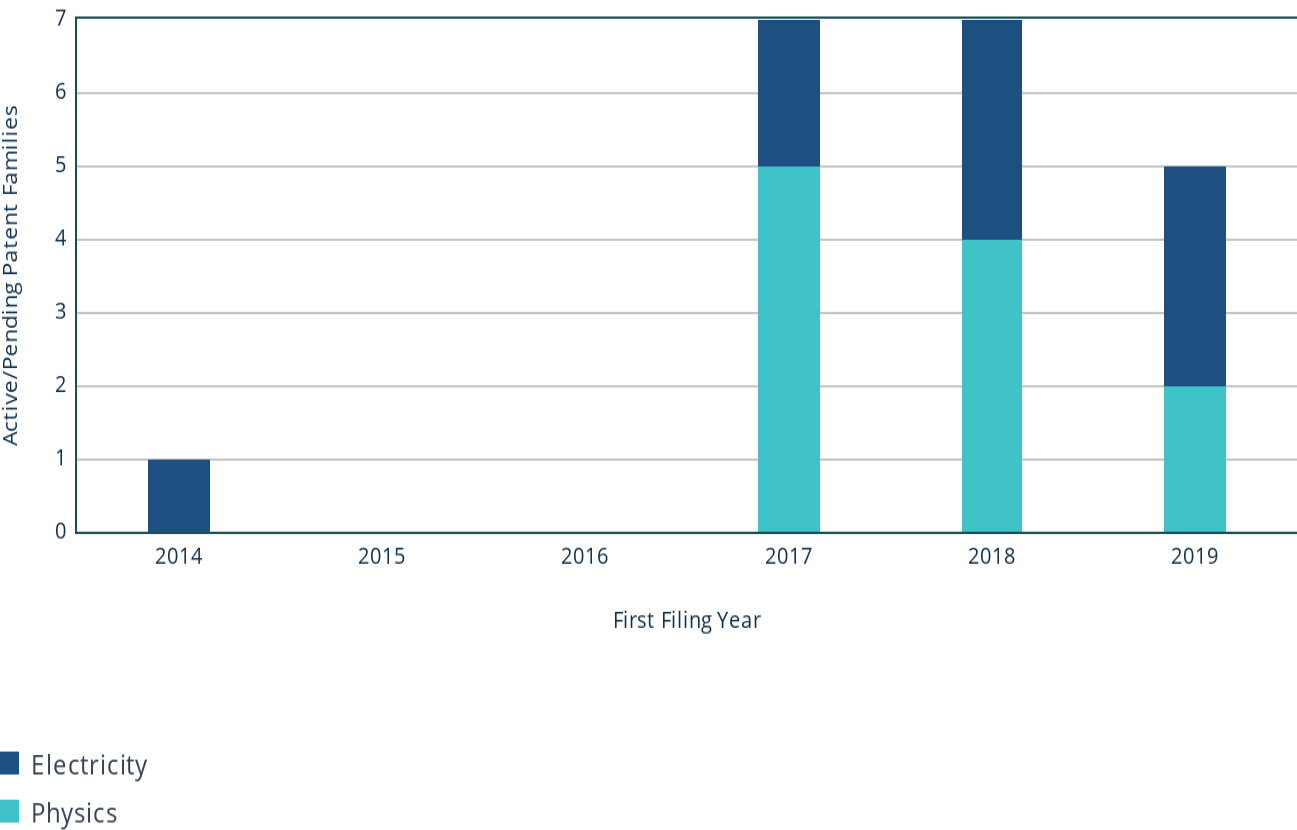

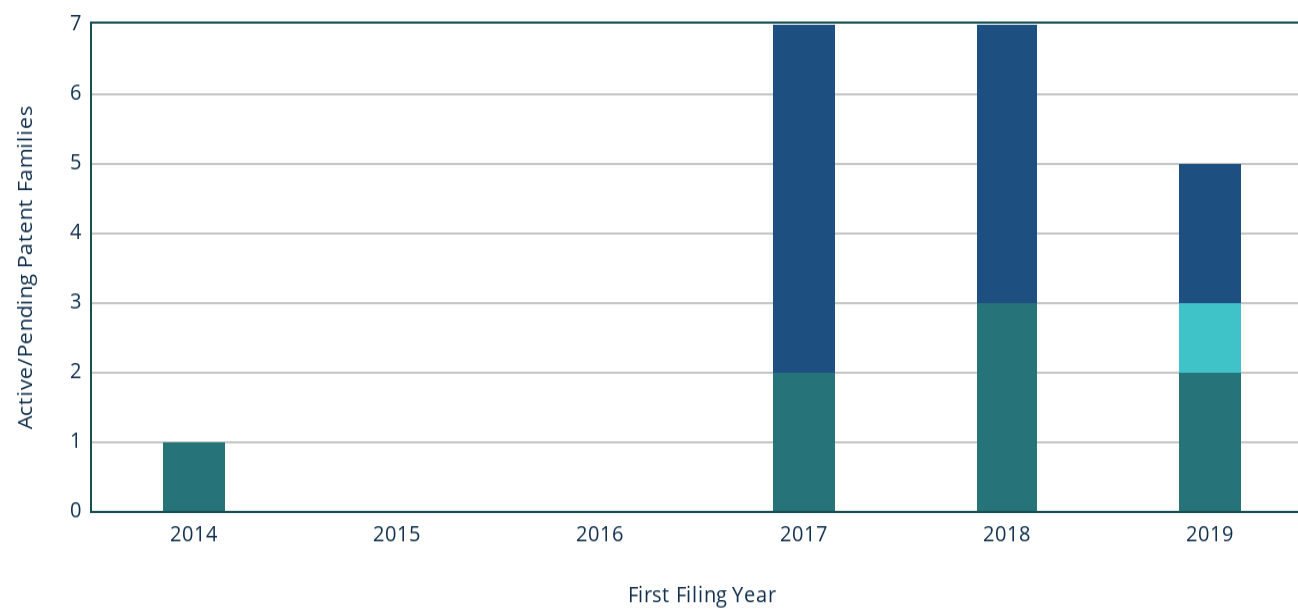

Patent Technology: CPC Section

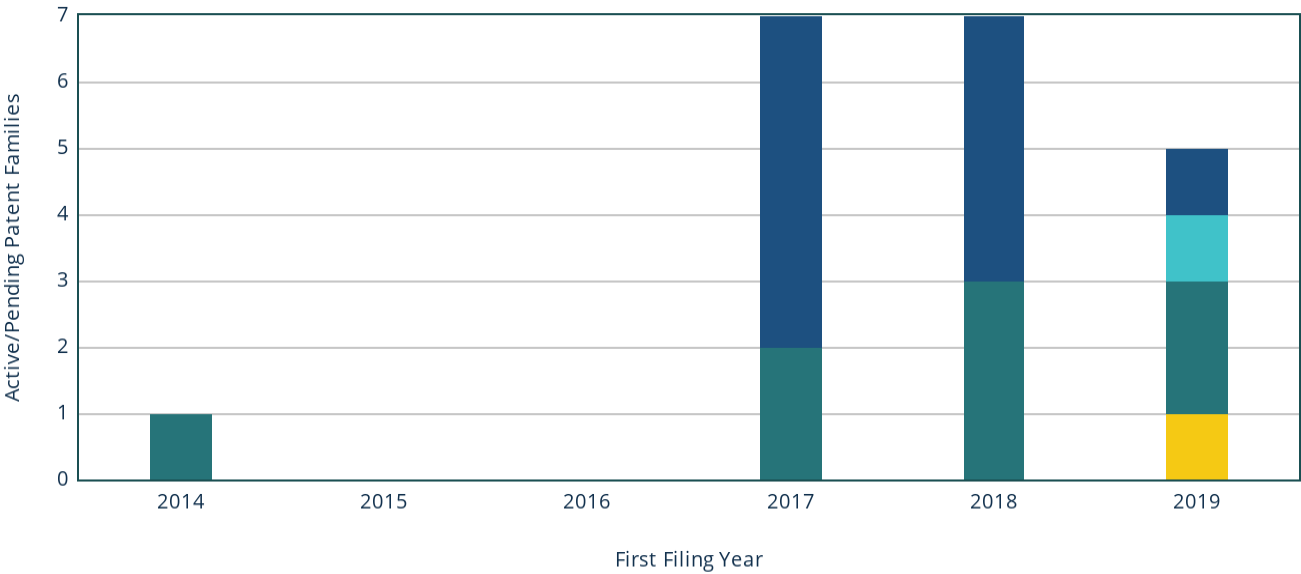


Patent Technology: CPC Class

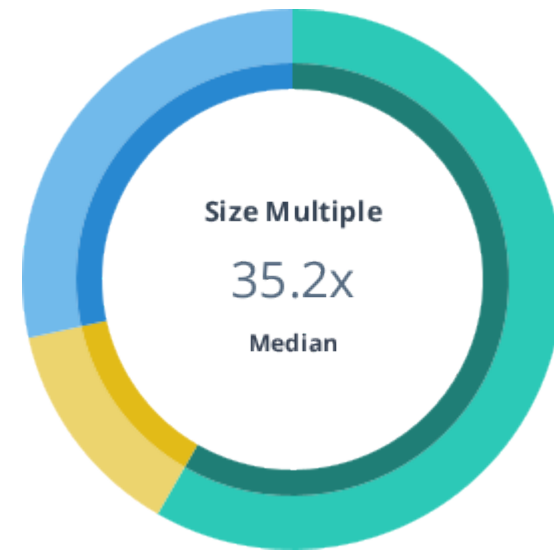

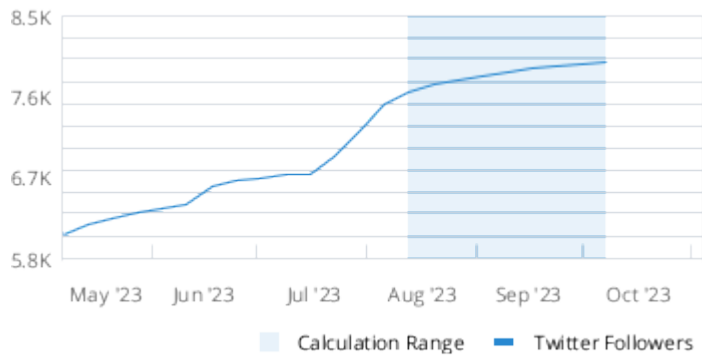

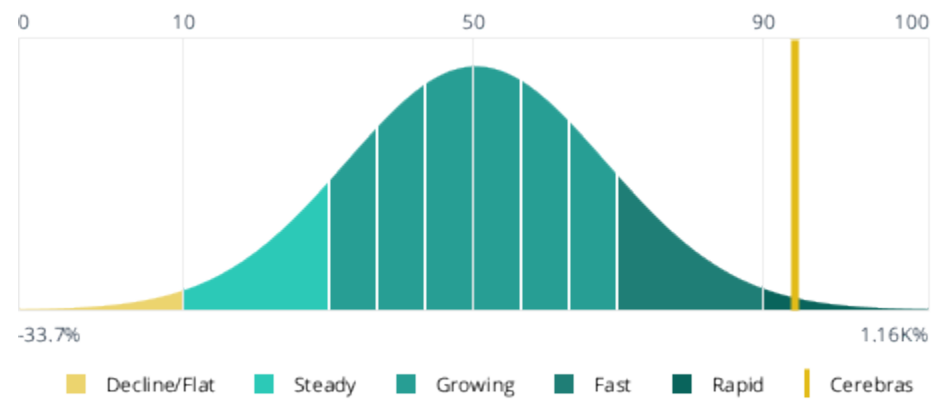

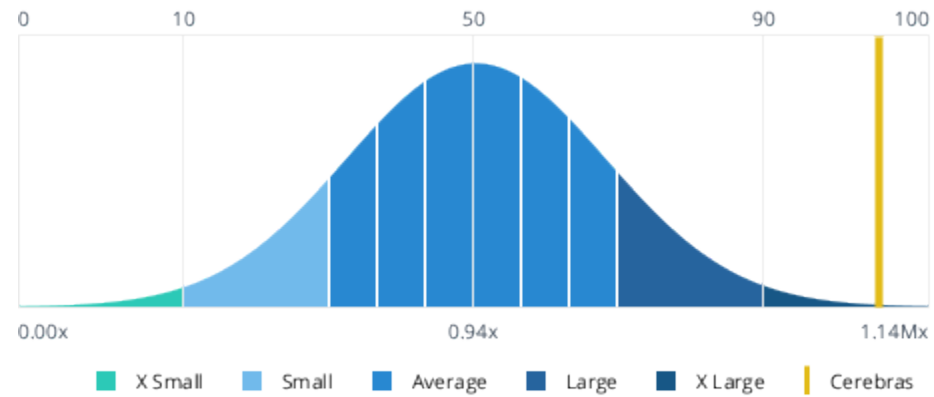

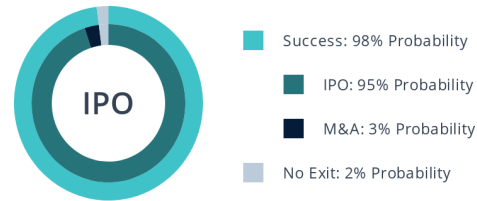
